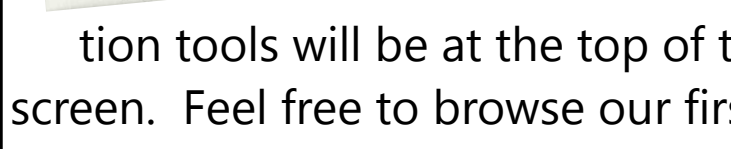

Did you know that bystanders who aid someone in an emergency using CPR, as well as businesses that want to place an AED on their premises, are not protected from liability under the current PA Good Samaritan Law?

We also will be asking members of the Senate to support House Bill 1400, legislation that would recognize accredited primary stroke centers as a first step toward improving overall stroke care across the Commonwealth.
